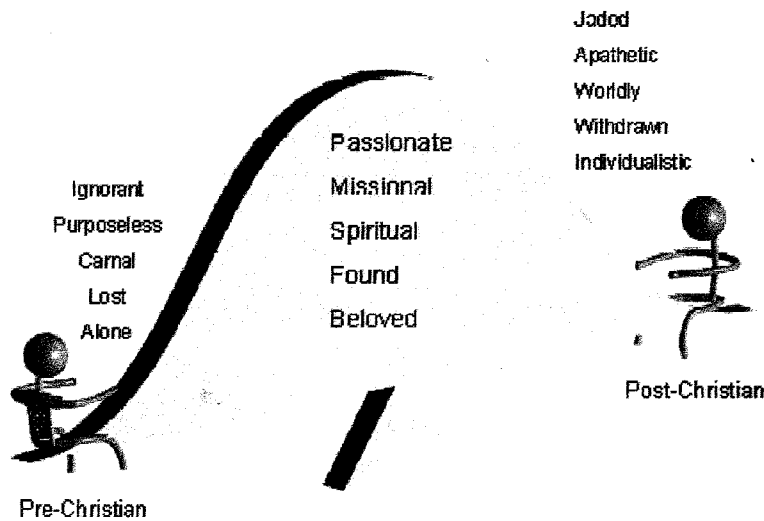

What are you doing to maintain your perspective and not to tilt away from spiritual health?

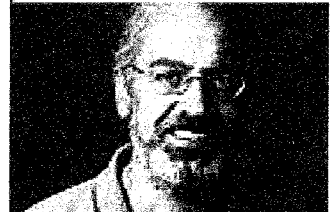
Where would you place your organization in this diagram? Its key leaders and constituents?
